Other activities include: co-Leader of Public & Nonprofit Management Practice of Schmalenbachgesellschaft (2005-2008); Member of Board of Trustees ZiF (2006-2008); Member of PM Georg Milbradt's Commission on Demography in Saxony (2005-2007); Member of Minister Christine Lagarde's Commission on Mondialisation (2008); and Member of Commission on Ethics and Economics of Wirtschaftsrat der CDU (2008-2009).
