## **Thomas Mueller**

Vice President for Oil Refining, Petrochemistry and Gas Processing, Lukoil

Thomas Mueller, who oversees LUKOIL's refineries in Russia and abroad, joined the company as an Advisor in 2005, later on Mr. Mueller held positions of Vice President for Global Refining (2007-2011), Director of Refining (end of 2012 - summer 2013), and recently he has been appointed as Vice President for Oil Refining, Petrochemistry and Gas Processing of the oil major.

From 1977 till 2005, Thomas Mueller was an employee at ConocoPhillips, where he started his career path as a technical services engineer at the company's refinery in Lake Charles; and then three years later moved to corporate headquarters in Houston and held various positions in refining operations, planning and strategic planning groups. Then Thomas Mueller was transferred to England to become Director of Economics and Planning for the Humber Refinery (1984). Two years later he returned to the US as Head of Retail Sales in Conoco's subsidiary Kayo. In 1989, Mr. Mueller returned to Houston, where he progressed through several management positions in planning, corporate strategy and portfolio management. In 1998, he was named Production Manager at the Refinery in Oklahoma. One year later he returned to England where he managed the Humber refinery. He relocated in 2002 to assume the position of General Manager for Refining Services in the Central District of the US.

Thomas Mueller holds a bachelor's degree in chemical engineering and an LLD degree.
