He has been National Grid's Assembly Member of the European Network of Transmission System Operators for Electricity since 2009 and was elected as its President in June 2013. Nick is also a member of Commissioner Oettinger's CEO group on the EU Infrastructure Package and the Energy Roadmap to 2050, and is the Chairman of CIGRE UK (International Council on Large Electric Systems).

Nick joined National Grid Company plc in 1993, becoming Director of Engineering in 2001. Prior to this, Nick started his career with the state owned Central Electricity Generating Board in 1983 where he served in a variety of technical engineering roles.
