Simone Mori, Executive Vice President, Regulation, Innovation and Environment, Enel SpA

After receiving a degree in physics and an MBA, Simone Mori held several positions at Enel SpA. Since 1996, he has been involved with the internal and strategic reorganization of Enel after the Italian electricity market liberalization and Enel's privatization.

In February 2004, he became responsible for Enel regulatory affairs, and in February 2007 he became head of the Regulation and Corporate Strategy Department, currently named Regulation and Environment.

He coordinates all activities of the Enel Group in the field of regulation, in Italy and abroad. He is vice president of Assoelettrica, chairman of the Assolombarda Energy Merchandise, president of the energy sector of the Industrial Union of Rome, a member of the Energy Commission of Confindustria, and member of the CESI Board of Directors. He also teaches at the Faculty of Engineering of the "La Sapienza" University of Rome.
