#### What's needed? - Under way:

- **Speedy implementation** 2. Horizon 2020 projects of the Alternative Fuels Directive



- 3. Standardisation of biomethane by CEN
- 4. Standardisation of filling stations by CEN



#### What's needed? – Yet to be initiated:

regulation of particles, NOx and noise

1. Air quality: Stricter 2. Public procurement: **Prioritise transport** modes emitting less and making less noise

3. Infrastructure: Allow DSOs to include costs in their regulated asset base

4. Diversity: Do not exclude combustion engines in future policies (White Paper)



#### What's needed? - Yet to be initiated:

- 1. Consumer information: 2. GHG assessment: Standardise measures + allow comparison between fuels
- 3. Well-to-wheel studies: Include the share of renewable gas

On the basis of lifecycle analysis, not tailpipe emissions



4. Fairness: Consult the gas sector on fuel studies (Commission)
