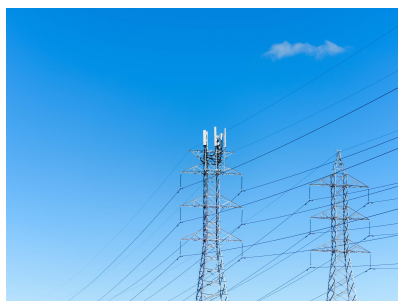

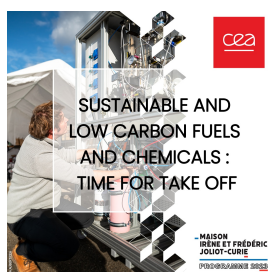
Krakowski Holding Komunalny SA becomes Associate Member of the EEF
